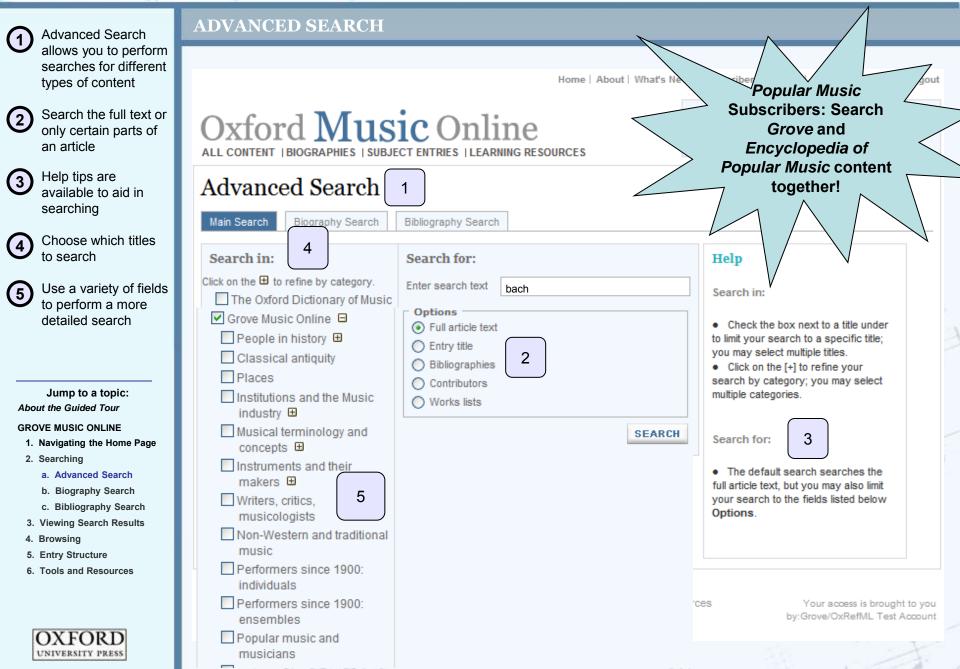

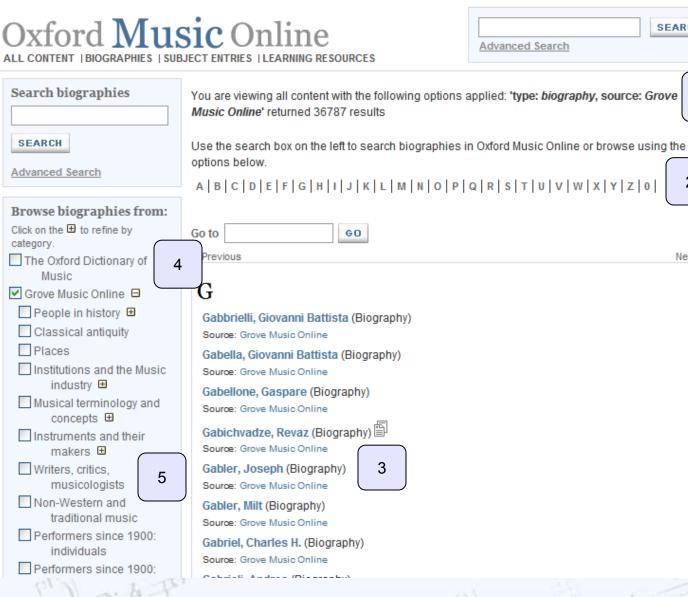

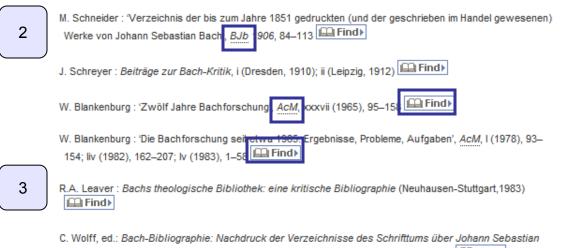
Throughout his life Bach was his own severest critic. Even in works which went through two or three different versions, like the chorale prelude *An Wasserflüssen Babylon* Bwv653, the 'final' version does not represent a definitive one but merely a further stage in the search for perfection – the central and ultimate concern of Bach's method of composition.

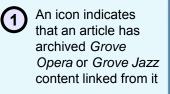
